

Commuting Sentiment Survey

CarGurus surveyed more than 1,200 commuters who drive to school or work, to find out how they feel about their time behind the wheel.



72% of commuters drive, representing the most popular way to commute, followed by public transportation, working from home, walking, rideshares, biking and other.



More than 70% of driving commuters spend 30 minutes or less one way on their commute.

More than one third of commuters drive because it's the most convenient option, and 20% of drivers say it's the fastest.

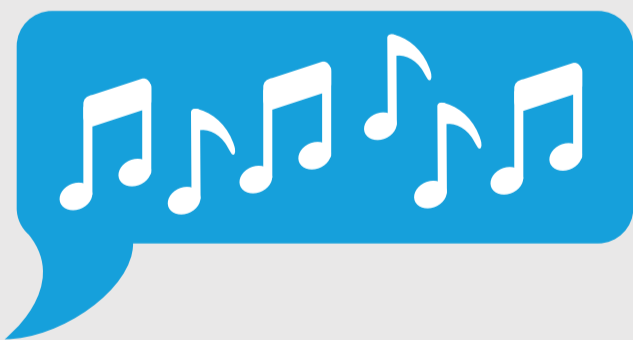
Possible Potty Mouths
